





% of Population That is Foreign Born by County 2006-2010






#### 2000 & 2010 Ethnic Composition

#### By Race & Ethnicity 2010







### Nevada's Population Pyramid, the Segments





#### **Year-over-Year Domestic & International Migration** 1999-2010






### Nevada's Migrants: Who Are They?

Domestic Migration (2000-2010) as a % of the 2000 Population



International Migration (2000-2010) as a % of the 2000 Population












### Nevadans' Languages: English vs. Spanish





% of Population 5 & Over Who Speak Spanish at Home, by County 2006-2010











# Nevadans' Educational Attainment: Ethnic Differences




#### **Educational Attainment by Ethnicity & Race** 2011 (Over 25 Years Old)



# Clark County Hispanic Population, by ZIP Code: Where Are They Living?








