This office is in receipt of your respective Petition Raw Counts setting forth the total raw count of signatures submitted for The Education Initiative Petition. Enclosed is a breakdown by petition district and county of the raw counts forwarded to the Secretary of State's office. In total, **152,713** signatures have been submitted with the various counties with the following petition district breakdown:
